### **Why join:**

With pending legislation making the packaging industry responsible for the recycling of their products, being part of an industry body and an Industry Waste Management Plan has become compulsory. The Gazetted registration of producers has added to this pressure.

The Polystyrene Association of SA is a single voice of the industry with a budget approved to represent the industry and thereby enhancing the status of members favourably to sell more.

### **Membership cost:**

The cost to converters of polystyrene packaging is R92 per kg, which is less than 0.05% of raw material cost, enabling the industry goals to be reached.

### **Achievements to date include:**

- An increase in recycling of packaging polystyrene by 17% in the last year.
- Establishing specific recycling projects for polystyrene and thereby ensuring recycling targets are met.

Without our industries membership and support we will not reach recycling targets set, we need to reach critical mass with 100% representation of industry.
